All-American Rowing Camp has always been about increasing the number of people that enjoy the sport of rowing in a safe, fun and positive way! Rowing is growing now to include more coastal rowing and we have been in support of coastal rowing since the start. This camp will be our first dedicated Coastal Experience and will include boats that are designed for the rougher waterways. Another aspect of coastal rowing is a way to expand the waterways that people can row.

This camp will focus on the rowing techniques, equipment and water that will help those interested in rowing a coastal single either in race situations but also to expand your season or comfort in different kinds of water.

Coach Ryan Worth with other coaches will be instructing you on boat and oar set up, how to launch and propel a coastal boat on flat water from a dock, wet launching and in moving tidal waters as well as surf and swells if the conditions permit. Camp will start at Lake Beresford but will transition to the Intracoastal waterway, Mosquito Lagoon, Ponce Inlet and hopefully the Atlantic Ocean. Safety will be paramount in this camp and will be stressed through the camp. Gig coxed quads will also be used during some of the sessions to help simulate the rowing of a coastal 4x.

Coach Ryan Worth will give plenty of on and off water instruction. Immediate video review as well as plenty of time for questions will highlight the off-water portion of the camp. Most meals are also provided to keep the learning time maximized. Rowing is a social sport so you will meet fun people along the way.
